What is TUMO?

TUMO is a free after-school program designed for teens. Since the program's launch in 2011, four TUMO centers have opened their doors in Armenia: in Yerevan, Dilijan (in collaboration with the Central Bank), Gyumri and Stepanakert (in collaboration with AGBU). A new, fifth TUMO center is planned to launch in the northern border village of Koghb, in Tavush, in 2018. Under the TUMO educational program, students get acquainted with four main focus areas: animation, web design, game development and filmmaking; and ten complementary skills including robotics, programming, photography, music, and more.
